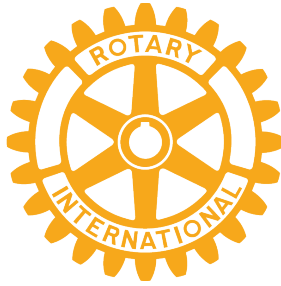

Explain how the project complies with the Mission of the Rotary Foundation:-

Regenerate meets all three objectives of the Rotary Foundation District Grant: improving health, supporting education and the alleviation of poverty for hundreds of kids in one of the poorest areas of London.

Regenerate works with young people in the Putney Heath and Roehampton Ward and are raising funds to improve young people's health through food and fitness.

Background

The Wandsworth Joint Strategic Needs Assessment 2014 found that 31% of children were living in poverty, a figure that is often hidden by the wealth of surrounding areas. 66% of children are supported by Pupil Premium on free school meals (Ofsted). Young people from this area grow up facing multiple issues including crime, drugs and gang involvement, abuse, lower educational attainment, and chronic unemployment. 1 in 4 adults and 1 in 10 children experience mental health problems. Poverty increases the risk of mental health problems and can be both a causal factor and consequence of ill mental health (The Mental Health Foundation's 2016 Policy Review). Furthermore, rates of mental health problems reported among children and young people have risen over the last fifty years. The Health Profile for Roehampton (2018) produced by Wandsworth Council indicates that local youths have limited access to social opportunities in the immediate area, a large proportion live in poverty and many live in lone-parent households, often where the parent is not in employment. Youths in deprived areas with high levels of social housing (such as Roehampton) may experience high levels of instability and struggle to cope with everyday life. This may manifest itself in young people presenting with challenging and chaotic behaviour which have long-term health and wellbeing impacts.

After identifying the unique needs of the community they work in, Regenerate sought insight on what skills could help to tackle those issues. Existing research on the desired outcomes of good youth work suggest that an improvement in soft skills such as goal setting and team work (Scotland Youth) can assist in tackling the needs of the young people in our community. Youth work which focuses on improving EET opportunities, building confidence through improving goal setting and team work skills has been identified by the National Youth Agency as vital to good youth work (National Youth Agency). Through extensive research, they've concluded that "excellent youth work serves to empower young people, through building their confidence and providing opportunities to mentor them through various stages in life."

Regenerate's aim is to ensure that vulnerable and at-risk young people in Wandsworth are leading healthier lives, and breaking barriers to the accessibility of sport. Due to living in areas of deprivation - the young people they work with on estates in Roehampton have a life expectancy 10 years lower than the Wandsworth borough average, so they are working to create opportunities for this to change.

Meals

Regenerate offer them every day at their youth club, where they make a huge portion of food to distribute. They try to honour the backgrounds of the young people they engage with. Some examples are: Ghanaian Jollof Rice or large portions of spaghetti bolognese or egg fried rice, Senegalese chicken dishes etc., and they try to vary their menu offering. Regenerate's overall goal is to make sure that young people have a hot healthy meal guaranteed after school (66% of our beneficiaries receive free school meals and so this guarantees that there is a meal outside of school lunch as well).



Sports sessions

Regenerate have a dedicated football session every Tuesday where young people who engage with them and their youth workers do football drills. They facilitate their sessions based on what the young people want to do - to make sure they're engaging them as best as they can. Sports sessions range from fitness sessions, basketball, indoor football, hockey, or boxing. One of our youth workers used to be a professional footballer and is a trained Personal Trainer and so he takes the feedback from the young people based on what activities they want to do and facilitates the sessions. The young people from these sessions are all Regenerate of a younger demographic - predominantly under 15s.

This project is in the deprived areas of Roehampton on the Alton and Ashburton Estates. The children are taken care of by the Regenerate staff. Currently all the cooking / washing up is done by their youth workers during their drop in sessions after school. Regenerate has been operating since 2000.

Funding Goals

Regenerate's current fundraising goal for their food and fitness campaign is £15,000 to be raised to fund 5000 meals over the coming year and £25,000 to be raised to fund 200 sports sessions on both the Alton Estate and the Ashburton Estate. The sports session funding will contribute to staff salaries, venue hire for our sessions on the Alton and equipment purchase.

Regenerate are fundraising to be able to provide 5000 hot healthy free meals for the young people we engage at Regenerate over the coming year. Tied into this we are fundraising to continue facilitating our sports sessions 4x a week across Putney and Roehampton. Costs will contribute to sessional staff salaries, venue hire and equipment. They've budgeted their fundraising target so that a meal cost around £3 per young person (obviously at no cost to them) and one sports session costs £125 - this covers staff salaries for the 3 hours of the session, the cost of venue rent and the cost of equipment.

MEALS GOAL – 5000 nutritious meals for the year @ £3 each = £15,000
SPORTS SESSIONS GOAL – 4 sessions/ week for 50 weeks = 200 @ £125 each = £25,000

Based on our budget of £3,700 between RC Putney & RC London, we can contribute:

- District 1130 Grant - 600 meals @ £3 per meal = £1,800 (600/5000 = 12% of funding goal)
- RC Putney & RC London funding - 15 sport sessions x £125 = £1,875 (15/200 = 7.5% of funding goal)
- Remaining £25 will go towards meals or any other expenses.

Evidence of funds spent will be provided in the way of receipts.

Amount of Funds Contributed by Club: £1,900

RC Putney: £1,000 and RC London: £900

This should at least match the District Grant requested.

N/A – the children are taken care of by the Regenerate staff. Currently all the cooking / washing up is done by their youth workers during their drop in sessions after school.

Reporting

The sponsoring club is required to complete and submit progress reports and final reports to the District Foundation Committee (interim report within six months of receipt of district grant money; final report within two months of completion of project). Failure to submit district grant reports are likely to affect future District Grant applications. The Chair of the Project Committee should have this responsibility.

Club Qualification Requirements

The club must have achieved “qualified” status, by:

- Attending the District Rotary Foundation Assembly,
- Completing the District Rotary Foundation MoU, and
- Completing the online Grants Management Seminar on the Learning Centre, accessed via My Rotary (or the 2024/25 Recertification if the Grants Management Seminar was previously completed).

Grants are subject to the availability of funds.

In June 2024, the Grants Subcommittee agreed to new provisions to encourage clubs to collaborate on District Grant projects to increase our impact. These are outlined below.

- Previously, a club could submit a maximum of one District Grant application for up to £900 per application.
- Each club will continue to be able to participate in a maximum of one District Grant application. However, the cap is now **up to £900 per club**.
- **Up to five clubs can collaborate on a single project/application**, qualifying for up to £900 x 5 = £4,500 of District Grant per application.
- **Each club must continue to meet required club contributions on a 1:1 basis**. This can potentially see the delivery of projects of up to £9,000 with the support of District Grants, opening up exciting possibilities for larger, more impactful collaborative projects by our clubs.
- **Clubs can continue to apply as a single entity** but can also now collaborate with other clubs to deliver bigger projects.
- **Clubs must fulfil club qualification requirements** to participate in Foundation grants. Grants are subject to the availability of funds.
