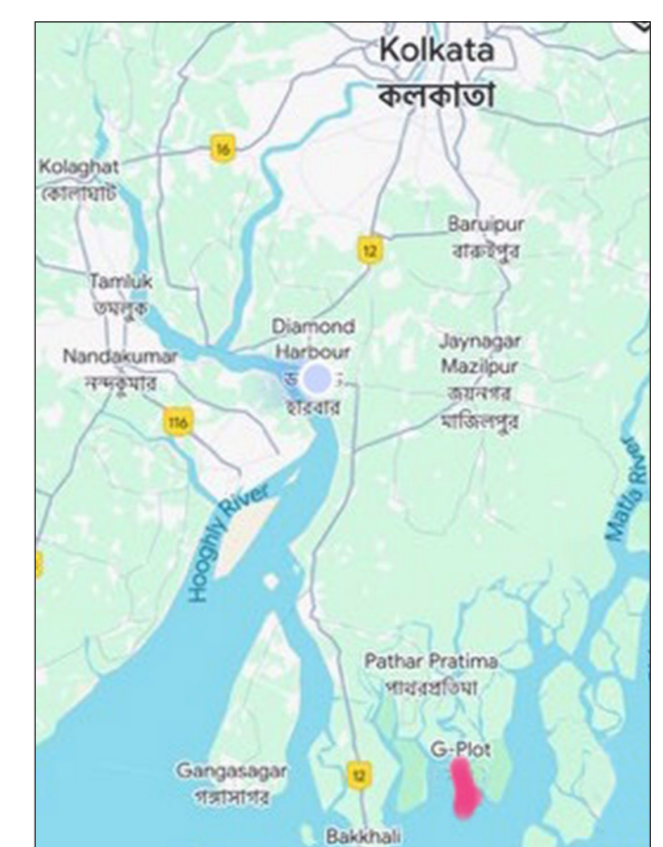
## G- Plot Island

**Sundarbans** is one of the world's most delicate and sensitive ecological treasures. Apart from myriad species of animals and plants, it is home to the seriously endangered Bengal Tiger.



**G-Plot**, the unnamed island - Human habitation and forest, isolated from the mainland. Sea-facing - 4 metres above sea level, non-drowning island with high vulnerability of cyclonic storms.

Population 7000 homes c.28,000 residents on small remote island with 20 km road. Only accessible by boat - 5 Hours from Kolkata by road and sea.
