## Water & Sanitation in Schools

The two schools featured are situated on and near the last Island of Sundarbans, known as G Plot, which is the 'Lands End' of India before the Bay of Bengal.

This school sanitation project complies with the Mission of the Rotary Foundation by improving the opportunities for children to receive good education in an enhanced healthy environment. Teachers also encourage the children to understand the need for cleanliness in order to prevent disease. Up to now Girls have found it difficult to stay at school after puberty where there is little privacy and proper sanitation.

**A further 5 school projects are in the pipeline as District and Global Grants.**

The project is the installation of a block of 5 new toilets in a junior school which will include 2 toilets for Boys, 2 for Girls, and 1 for Staff. Currently the school has grossly inadequate toilets and wash facilities. Water will be supplied to the new toilet block with an existing submersible pump.

The project: the installation of a submersible water pump with 1.5-inch pipeline 600 ft deep, a 1000 litre water tank, 200 ft 4-inch pipe to reservoir/ the water tank, and plumbing for 4 toilets and wash room with material and labour.
